

## Letter from the Pastor

Dear Friends in Jesus,

As April begins, we come again to our observance of Palm/Passion Sunday and the "Three Days" or "Triduum" – the ancient title for the period that begins on Maundy Thursday evening and ends on Easter Sunday evening. If you have never taken the time to experience the power of these holy days focusing on the suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus, why not make this the year, especially as our worship continues to return to a more "pre-COVID" feel? Our schedule of worship and related activities will be as follows:

#### • Sunday of the Passion/Palm Sunday, April 2:

At **9:00am**, we will proceed with our normal in-person Faith Formation activities. At **10:15am**, we will likewise join in our new normal "hybrid" worship, combining in-person and Zoom opportunities and, while we will not have a procession of palms of any sort, we will be handing out our beautiful Equal Exchange palms to those present in-person (and have them available for a day or two beforehand for picking up here at the church for those who will be Zoom-ing that morning). Our worship will begin with the Liturgy of the Palms and we will again enjoy Vincent Lamenza's reading of The Passion of Jesus (this year According to St. Matthew) as the center point of our worship.

#### • Maundy Thursday, April 6:

At 7:00 P.M., we will gather (both in-person and on Zoom) for a Liturgy of Holy Communion, sharing in the mystery and the meaning of that Upper Room – the body and the blood given for us – the betrayal and desertion of our Lord. Reflecting that betrayal and desertion, for the first time since the COVID years, our worship will end with the solemn stripping of the altar by members of altar guild as the senior choir intones the haunting words of Psalm 22.

#### Good Friday, April 7:

At 7:00 P.M., we will gather (both in-person and on Zoom) for the Liturgy of Good Friday – a dark and solemn, and yet hopeful, time when we hear again of the extent of Jesus' great love and sacrifice for you and me. Members of Youth Group and Pastor Tom will again lead us in our worship.

#### Holy Saturday, April 8:

At 9:00 A.M., members of Youth Group will set up for our annual Easter Egg Hunt, with the hunt getting underway at 10:00 A.M. for children in four age groups: preschool, grades K-1, grades 2-3, and grades 4-5. At 7:00 P.M., we will continue our worship downstairs with a Liturgy of Readings and Prayer, which will not be available on Zoom, with the much smaller and quieter and darker setting of our downstairs chapel. This liturgy, a part of the ancient liturgy of Easter Vigil, features a series of lengthy readings from the Old Testament, telling of the creative and saving actions of God, beginning with Genesis 1, that point the way to the ultimate creative and saving action of Easter. There will be no music and no offering – only my reading by the light of a single candle, silence for meditation, and prayer.

#### • The Resurrection of Our Lord, Easter Day, April 9:

We will once again gather in-person for a brief time of Sunrise Worship at **6:30am** in the field across from the pavilion, next to the sexton house (or under the pavilion roof in case of inclement weather). At **9:00am**, we will again proceed with our normal Faith Formation activities. And at **10:15am**, we will likewise join in our new normal "hybrid" worship, combining in-person and Zoom opportunities as we celebrate the Good News that Jesus is Risen!

And it occurs to me that I would be remiss if I didn't also mention that, on **April 16**, this **Second Sunday of Easter** will once again be the day of our **Easter Celebration Worship**. While the rest of the world will have already stored away the Easter decorations, concluding that Easter is over and done, we choose to live the truth that Easter is, in fact, a "week of weeks" – 49 days plus 1 – and our young persons, guided by Miss Laurie, will lead us in continuing that celebration. As Miss Laurie and the young persons continue to remind us, our God Is a Great Big God! Let's prepare to celebrate together just How Great and just How Big!!

I will look forward to being in worship with YOU, my sisters and brothers in this wonderful congregational family that is St. John, in this most Holy of times. Please don't hesitate to contact me with any questions or ideas!

# Midweek Bible Study

Our spring session of Midweek Bible Study will get underway on Wednesday, April 19 and run for six weeks, meeting each week from 6:30 to 8:00pm and wrapping up prior to Memorial Day weekend. Prior to April 19, the folks who have signed up will make the decision whether we will meet in a hybrid fashion (in-person with a Zoom option) or via Zoom only – Pastor Tom will be open to doing whatever the group decides. For our spring study, we will be "following the lead" of Book Discussion Group, reading and discussing the acclaimed book *Walking the Bible* by Bruce Feiler, in which he engages us in his experiences of traveling over and through those lands we commonly refer to as the "Holy Lands", helping us see familiar biblical passages with new perspectives. Depending on how our gatherings run, we may finish with a May 24 Movie Night to take in the film based on the book together, maybe even with popcorn! *To take part in this spring study, you do not have to have taken part in Book Discussion Group in March or April – nor will you be "bored" if you did!* And, as always with these studies, no previous Bible study experience is required – only an interest and enthusiasm to study, reflect on, and (if and when you are comfortable doing so) discuss God's Word together! So that the correct number of study books can be ordered for our study, please register in advance (by speaking with Pastor Tom) and let him know if you will need a copy of the book by the end of the day on Maundy Thursday, April 6.
