Letter from the Pastor

Dear Friends in Jesus,

If you are reading this letter after Easter Day, March 31, and you happen to take a look around you, you will pretty quickly be tempted to conclude that Easter has come and gone – the bunnies and eggs and all the rest will have been quickly put away in favor of the next big thing on the calendar – perhaps the patriotic display leading into Memorial Day and the beginning of the summer travel season. It's how our secular, consumer-driven, calendar works, after all.

But it is definitely <u>not</u> how our liturgical, Jesus-centered, calendar works. And it is to <u>that</u> calendar that I want to encourage you to pay attention...

You see, for Christians, Easter – the cosmos-changing news that Jesus has overcome sin and death and the grave – is simply way too big to be covered in one quick day. And so, for many centuries now, Christians have very wisely set aside not just one day... not just several days... not just a week... but actually a "week of weeks" – 7 weeks plus one day, or 50 days in total – to be reminded again and again and again and, just maybe, have it sink in at least a little bit. You see, we need that time – we need that reminding – because the news of Easter is so unlike anything else we have ever heard or will ever hear in the rest of our lives – Good News that radically and completely overpowers all of the bad news of which we tend to hear so much. So, please make it your plan this year to make use of all 7 of the Sundays of Easter to be in worship with your congregational family. And during those 50 days...

On the 40th Day of Easter, Thursday, May 9, we will observe the festival of Ascension of Our Lord when we will host a joint worship at 7:00pm including our United Church of Christ neighbors of their "Northern Cluster". For that evening, we have invited Mr. Thomas Dressler to come and serve as our organist for worship. Tom is a professional organist, harpsichordist, speaker, and music director from Albrightsville, PA who first established a link with our congregational family when he came to do research in our archives concerning Pastor J. Michael Enderlein, from whom he is descended and whose possible connections with the great Johann Sebastian Bach as a young man back in Germany Tom is researching. While here, Tom thoroughly enjoyed playing our organ and expressed the hope that he might return some time and play for worship, with this being the result. Our worship order will celebrate Jesus' Triumphant Ascension in scripture and prayer, with a very generous measure of Tom's organ skills spread throughout.

And then, on the 50th Day of Easter, Sunday, May 19 – we call it the Day of Pentecost – we will celebrate with several of our young members who will be confirmed in their faith and share together in Word and Sacrament during our 10:15am worship. You won't want to miss it!

Blessings to you and yours this (50-day-long) Easter Season, now just begun. Christ Is Risen! He Is Risen Indeed!! Alleluia!!!

Strawberry Festival Committee Meeting on March 11, 2024

Compliance on background checks – Cecilia Boyer has agreed to make sure compliances are completed every 5 years and our in good standings.

Summer Camp – Amy Gehring had a number of young folks interested in attending camp who are not members of St Johns but do attend and our active in our Sunday worship services on a regular basis, she asked if they would also qualify for the 50% discount we provide for baptized Members of St. John. It was discussed that camp costs could be around \$530. Recommendation was given by Craig Peters that we do this on a trial bases, Amy Gehring and Pastor Tom review the young person's attendants and with their recommendations that we help with non-member's camping expenses as we do for Members of St. John, 2nd by Justin Adams. Motion approved unanimously.

Unfinished business:

Security Cameras- Joshua Paul reviewed camara systems at retailer (Best Buy) and was not satisfied with his findings and recommended we be in contact with an actual security expert, who can address any technical questions and proper installation of the cameras, he recommended Shearer Security in Harrisburg. Craig Peters recommended MIS Surveillance located in Millersburg. Council members agreed to get quotes from both of these companies and request someone from the property committee to be present when analyses/ quotes are being done, Sandra Lamenza will contact Carl Baumgardner of the property committee.

New Business

Pavilion Expansion- Finance and Property committee have requested a congregational meeting for Sunday February 25, 2024 to review and approve the expansion of the pavilion for a takeout area for the Strawberry Festival. Estimated cost is 15,000 to \$20,000, Donations have already been offered, recommendation was given that anyone who wants to make a contribution may do so. Ty Troutman gave a review of the project. Motion was made by Sandra Lamenza 2nd by Christie Kahler for the congregational meeting. Motion approved unanimously.

Adjournment: Motion by Josh Paul to adjourn the meeting. 2nd by Ty Troutman. Motion approved unanimously. Meeting was closed with the lord's Prayer.
