As you might have observed over the years, many christian congregations take a long siesta during the summer months — Vacation Bible School is held, along with regular Sunday morning worship, but not much else (including, usually, Sunday School, which goes on hiatus until the return of September). That is <u>not</u> our experience here on The Hill, with the Annual Strawberry Festival in June and the Annual Yardsale in August, in addition to a very busy week of Vacation Bible School in July and ongoing weekly Sunday School. And I am glad of that! In addition, this summer, the work of the Prayerful Planning Group is pushing forward, and I'd like to share with you a brief report about where things stand.

The part of the Group that is focused on strengthening our Sunday School ministry is already looking forward to 2015, and searching for a person or persons who would be willing to coordinate an Easter Program for our children and youth. The hope is to do a program that would be similar in form to our Annual Advent/Christmas Program (Which will be continuing this coming December, just like always – this new program has no effect on that!) but, instead of having the Easter Program in an evening setting, with a dinner, it is planned that the Easter Program would take place during 10:15 A.M. worship on the Sunday following Easter Sunday – the Second Sunday of Easter, (April 12 of 2015) – and hopefully become an annual event. Tentatively, practice would begin during Sunday School on the 3rd Sunday in Lent (March 8 next year) and then run for four consecutive Sunday School sessions, through Palm Sunday. There would be no practice on Easter Sunday morning, and then final practices would take place one evening during the week following Easter Sunday and during the Sunday School hour on April 12. The part of the Group that is focused on "ramping up" our ministry with children and youth by working toward calling a part-time coordinator of these ministries has organized a varied and enthusiastic team of persons (youth, youth advisors, young parents, newer members, long-time members) to come together to start the "nuts and bolts" work of developing a plan of finances, duties, time schedule, etc. that will eventually come before our whole congregational family for action. That team will have its first gathering here at the church on **Wednesday**, **July 2**, **from 6:30 to 8:00 P.M.** Want to help, or want to learn more? The part of the Group that is focused on our facilities, specifically a new kitchen and onsite preparation area for our Annual Strawberry Festival and the longer-term vision of a new social hall, is working right through the summer to refine the concept of these facilities, prior to the preparation of actual plans and cost estimates that will eventually come before our whole congregational family for action.
