A Letter from The Pastor.....

Dear Friends in Jesus,

Hopefully by now, you've heard more than once about our congregational family plans for Sunday, August 13 – the day of the official Elizabethville Bicentennial Celebration Worship – but I wanted to use this space this month to go over the details one more time. We will begin the morning in the usual way, with Adult and Jr./Sr. High Sunday School here at St. John from 8:45 to 9:15 A.M. Then, we will make our way to the Upper Dauphin Area High School Auditorium to join with our Christian Sisters and Brothers in this once-in-a-lifetime worship opportunity which begins at 10:30 A.M., and with which I will be assisting. Several things about this worship and the rest of the afternoon:

+All offerings received will be split between the Upper Dauphin and Northern Dauphin Human Services Centers. This means that you shouldn't use any St. John offering envelopes at the school, as they will not be able to be properly recorded, and that the best way to give your regular August 13 Sunday offering to your home congregation will be to "double up" on either the preceding or the following Sundays.

+Miss Laurie will be leading an area-wide children's choir, which will sing during both the worship and the early afternoon religious concert. This group will hold a first rehearsal here at the church on Sunday, July 30, at 2:00 P.M. Please see her to learn more about this opportunity for our young persons in Grade 6 and younger.

+Following worship, everyone present will be invited to join in a "picnic" lunch in the high school cafeteria and adjacent outside seating area. Each of the organizing congregations is contributing food items for this cost-free meal, and each household attending is being asked to bring along a dessert and a drink to share.

- +Following this luncheon time, at approximately 12:30 P.M., everyone will be invited to return to the auditorium for a concert of religious music.
- +Carol Hubler and Judy Ferree will be leading all interested St. John congregational family members in two pieces as a part of this concert time a piece for men's voices and a piece for all voices. Rehearsals for these two songs will be held at the church on Mondays, July 24, July 31, and August 7, with the men rehearsing from 7:00 to 7:30 and all voices from 7:30 to 8:00 P.M.
- +There is also an opportunity for all interested folks to sing as part of a Greater Elizabethville Community Choir, under the direction of Mrs. Kasey Campbell of Salem Lutheran Church in Elizabethville, rehearsals for which will begin at Salem Lutheran from 7:00 to 8:00 P.M. on Wednesday, June 28. (Please note that there was a deadline of June 25 for signing up for this choir but, if you didn't get a chance to sign up and are interested in participating, please speak with me.)
