Dear Friends in Jesus,

My theme this month is "something old (two things, actually), something new". In the "old" category, I want first to highlight the fact that this issue of the *Epistle* contains the updated committee listing for our June 12 Annual Strawberry Festival, which details all of the different tasks that need to be done in order for the Festival to be a success. Please be sure to remove the listing and keep it handy (maybe on the refrigerator?), and please be sure to check with your committee chairperson, the overall chairpersons, or with Pastor Tom if you have any questions or concerns about your scheduled work. **The next planning meeting has been scheduled for Monday, May 6, from 6:30 to 8:00 P.M. – everyone is welcome!**

Also in the category of "old", I want to be sure that you notice that a registration form for Vacation Bible School (VBS) is also included in this *Epistle*. VBS will be held July 15-19, from 6:30 to 8:30 each evening, with a closing program on Sunday morning, July 21. We are using a new and exciting curriculum this year, which has been prepared by the World Hunger Appeal of our Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, entitled ***Taking Root: Hunger Causes, Hunger Hopes***. As is the case each year, there will be classes available for young persons from Pre-School through Senior High (note that this latter category is a slight change – no longer cutting VBS off at Grade 9 for older youth would like to participate). There will be a great mix of learning, storytelling, craft-making, fun with friends, and, yes, the snacks – all of it in the beautiful setting of The Hill. Planning is well underway, including help from some brand new faces, the excitement is building, and now we need your help in two ways. First, please "talk it up" and share the enclosed registration form with your young persons and their friends. Feel free to make as many copies of the form as you need, or see me for more, and please do your best to return your registrations to me or to any Sunday School teacher by mid-June. **Second, please consider whether you might be able to serve as a leader for the Grades 5&6 class (one person, or a team of persons, could serve in this role, as personal schedules may allow).** Please, please don't hesitate to contact any member of Sunday School Teachers & Officers or me with any questions. We are looking forward to a truly fun and truly inspiring week for all young persons!

In the category of "new", I wanted, finally, to highlight our new prayer shawl ministry. As the name suggests, a prayer shawl is a handmade knitted or crocheted covering for the head and shoulders that is provided to a person who finds him- or herself in a time where they are greatly in need of prayer for healing and wholeness – someone who is hospitalized, for instance. The shawl is a soft and warm reminder of the soft and warm embrace of our God and of the prayers that are surrounding the person in need. Barb Bullock introduced the concept to the Women of St. John some time ago and, in true St. John fashion, a number of persons took up the challenge of knitting shawls for this wonderful ministry – including some folks who are related to our congregational family. We will be blessing our first batch of prayer shawls during worship on April 28, and they will then be available for distribution. Periodically, we will join in blessing new prayer shawls as they are prepared. To learn more about this ministry, including information about making shawls, please contact Barb Bullock. If you are reading this article prior to April 28, look for the time of dedication and blessing that morning.

Thank you for staying with me and reading all this, and thank you for your partnership in the St. John Congregational Family as we continue our Easter mission of telling the world that ***Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!!***

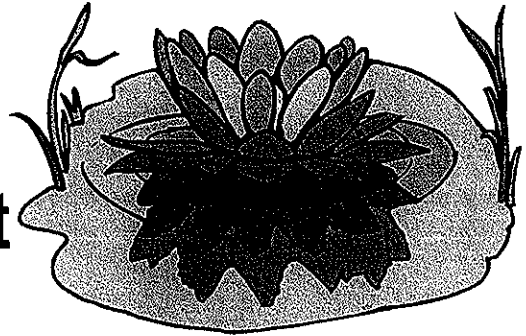

Motion by Jim Bullock, 2<sup>nd</sup> by John Ferree to accept the February Council minutes. Motion passed unanimously.

**Reception of Petitions and Communications:**

Letter from elevator company regarding annual service contract which will increase by 1.73%.

Gerrysburg Seminary is creating a new state of the art “Seminary Ridge Museum” which will highlight the role of the Seminary s a hospital after the battle and the life of faith and role of soldiers. They are soliciting “Rounders” who will be listed on the Founders Wall. Minimum gift is \$38 to be listed.

Motion by Ken Koller and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Craig Peters to contribute \$50 donation. Motion passed unanimously.

Pastor Tom received a call from the Upper Dauphin Recreation Association which is looking to reopen the E-ville pool. They were inquiring as to the possible use of the church property to hold an outdoor craft show fundraiser on a Saturday in April or early May. The Church Event Guidelines were discussed as well as insurance coverage. We had two visits from the PA State Plice in February responding to our elevator phone which was accidentally activated. Elevator phone has been reprogrammed so the appropriate people are notified before the call gets to the 911 call .

38 people were served at the 1<sup>st</sup> Community Service Dinner. 5 members of St. John's helped serve and our \$150 donation helped with the purchase of equipment and food for the dinner. A 2<sup>nd</sup> dinner will be upcoming.
