Dear Friends in Jesus,

Continuing with my “think summer” theme from last month, I particularly want to highlight the several changes coming to our worship at the end of this month, on the Sunday of Memorial Day weekend, May 26. That will be the morning that we once again switch to our **summer schedule** of 1. **Sunday School for Adults at 8:45 A.M. in the Conference Room**, with no opening, so that we simply join in the regular half-hour study session, ending by about 9:15, 2. **Worship at 9:30 A.M.**, ending promptly by 10:30 so that everyone can get on to those reunions and other summer Sunday plans (**this will also be the morning that we move out to the pavilion for the first of our outside summer worship opportunities**), and 3. **SONDay Celebration (Summer Sunday School for Grades 4 and younger) with Miss Laurie also at 9:30 A.M.** We look forward to another summer of worship here on The Hill, including seven Sunday mornings when we will gather outdoors in the beauty of God's Good Creation. And, as we speak of our Annual Strawberry Festival, please also make note of two other important Strawberry Festival-related dates coming up in the next few weeks: 1. The **next planning meeting** has been scheduled for **Monday, April 29**, beginning at **6:30 P.M.** and 2. The **first pavilion cleaning and preparation night, which will also serve as our spring outside work night on the church property in general**, has been set for **Tuesday, May 28**, beginning at **5:30 P.M.** (You might remember that, for the past few years, we have had good results combining what had previously been two work nights into one instead of trying to schedule two separate days and times, but this again means that we will again need lots of “hands” to pull off this busy evening of projects.)

May God bless and guide us as a congregational family as we anticipate the turning of the page to summer and, especially, as we continue our journey through the 50-Day and 7-Sunday long Season of Easter all this month!
